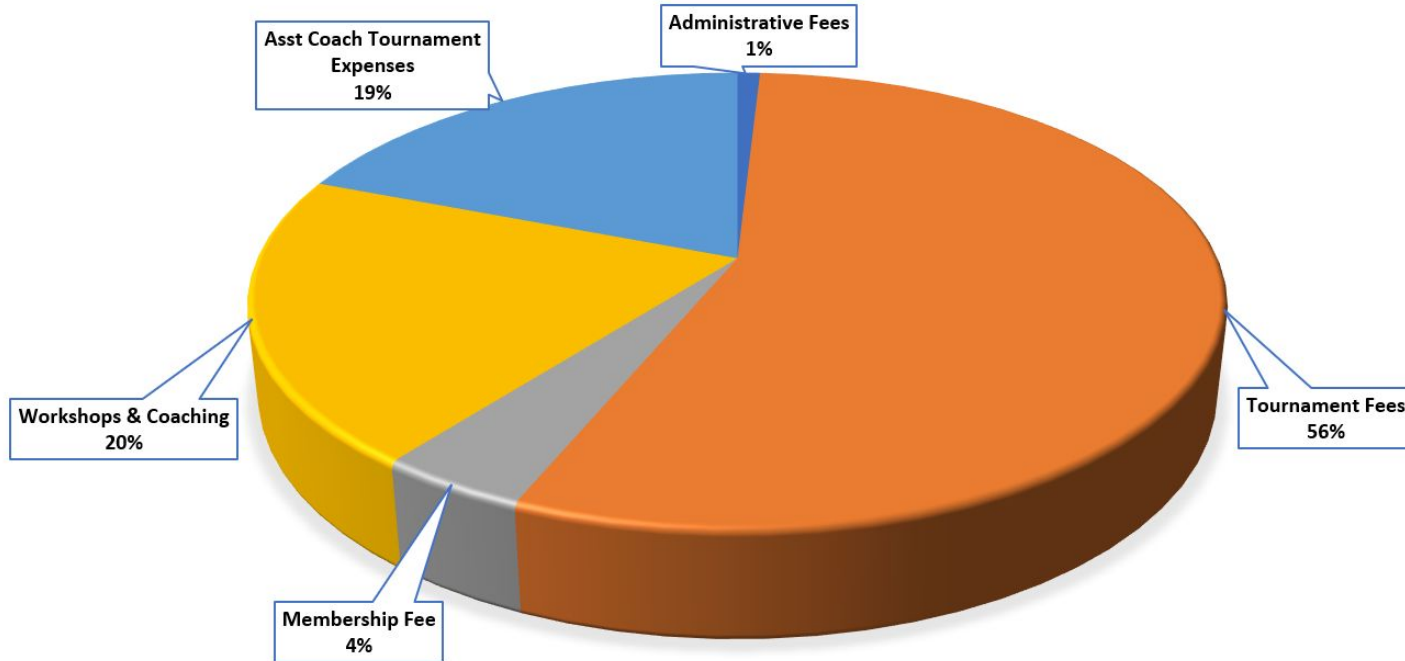

Why Judging?

- Involvement with your Kid's Activities
- Helps your Kid (They will seek your Advice!)
- Chance to see thoughtful side of your kids
- Network with other SD parents
- Tournament Requirement - Number of judges determined by tournament
- WITHOUT your judging help, kids may be not be able to go! Penalty fees are levied on teams!
- Free Food!!

Judging Dos/Dont's!

- Signup Early and Often
- Arrive On time/Stay till Completion
- Checkin-Checkout with the Coach of the Day
- Don't worry if you don't have prior judging experience
- Look out for Judge Training Session
- Create a Tabroom Account
- Bring a Book!
